The June Vestry meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Fr. Josh Stephens, our Rector. Those attending included: Senior Warden, John Barker, Junior Warden, Will Rodriguez, Clint Adams, Patrice German, Jerry Holt, Kim Sanders, Jennifer Shelton, and Laura Meherg Teel. Absent were Elizabeth Christenbury, E. R. Haire, Marisa Pharr, and Lynn Wiescholek.

Fr. Josh welcomed everyone and opened the meeting with prayer.

Acceptance of Consent Agenda for June: Will made a motion to accept all committee reports as well as the minutes of the May Vestry meeting; Clint seconded the motion, and it was passed.

Rector's Report: Fr. Josh outlined the following upcoming events:
